Assessment

 - Greater detail provided
 - Tested
 - No Performance Level = Total Tested
 - Not tested
 - Medically Excused
 - Admin Error
 - Refusal
 - Absent/No valid score (CBT: this includes NYSAA and ELL eligible students)
 - Incomplete
 - No assessment (PBT: this includes NYSAA and ELL eligible students)

Assessment - Regents

- Transition Regents Global History and Geography
 - Conversion chart available no later than June 22
 - All Transition Global tests should be scanned by June 20
- Regents process review
 - All SchoolTool districts have indicated that they want scores uploaded by us
 - Notify Test Scoring at testscoring@cnyric.org as soon as each subject is scored and completed
 - DO NOT let teachers enter scores manually
 - Uploading usually happens within 24 hours

Student Reporting

- Procedures for Obtaining NYSITELL/NYSESLAT Scores for Students Who Transfer Between NYS School District
 - NYSITELL one time screening tool
- Reporting safety net options for students with a 504 plan
 - Frontline IEP - now includes capability to report eligibility
 - Load manually from Frontline IEP “504 Plan - Safety Net extract”
 - 5775 Eligible for safety net in All Subjects under Section 504
- Teacher Student Data Linkage (TSDL)
 - Due: June 15, 2018; Certification: June 22, 2018
 - Certification will be in the IRS data exchange (Business Portal)
 - SIRS-315 Teacher Student Data Linkage (TSDL) Verification Report
 - SIRS-318 Staff Assignment Verification Report

Student Reporting (cont'd)

- **Post Secondary Credits (see your friendly neighborhood consultant)**
 - State relaxed 5 credit maximum. It will now be 10 credits. However, SchoolTool will not have an update until this summer. State will not be using this field this year.
 - BOCES dual credit courses - example (CTE)
 - Not mapped to a course code/no staff attached - does not report to DW
 - Listed only for transcript purposes
 - Not sure who these will be linked to the district
 - SIRS-330 Student Class Entry/Exit Verification Detail Report
 - SIRS-321 Student Class Grade Detail Verification Report; column added for Post-Secondary Credits.
- **LEP Duration**
 - 0231 Program Service ELL Eligibility code
 - ELL needs duration but should be duration in US Schools - not your district
 - Districts should report total duration including prior years

- SED has reduced the number of data elements LEAs need to submit for staff evaluation data but all educators must receive a full set of scores and ratings for their APPR results. <https://www.engageny.org/resource/resources-closeout-2017-18-appr>

Staff Reporting

New to 2017-18

- **Subcomponent ratings are no longer submitted**
 - Only scores should be submitted for all original and transition subcomponents
- **There are no placeholders for the Optional subcomponents**
 - If an optional subcomponent is not used, nothing is submitted
- **Category ratings are no longer submitted**
- **Only the following elements should be submitted:**
 - Original Required Student Performance subcomponent score
 - Original Optional Student Performance subcomponent score (as applicable)
 - Original Required Teacher Observation/Principal School Visit subcomponent score
 - Original Optional Teacher Observation/Principal School Visit subcomponent score (as applicable)
 - Original Overall Rating
 - Transition Required Student Performance subcomponent score (as applicable)
 - Transition Optional Student Performance subcomponent score (as applicable)
 - Transition Required Teacher Observation/Principal School Visit subcomponent score (as applicable)
 - Transition Optional Teacher Observation/Principal School Visit subcomponent score (as applicable)
 - Transition Overall Rating (as applicable)



Note: Educators will still receive a full evaluation, including all subcomponent scores and ratings, category ratings and an Overall rating (addressed later in this presentation).
