**WHO:** Data administrators, high school administrators and high school counselors

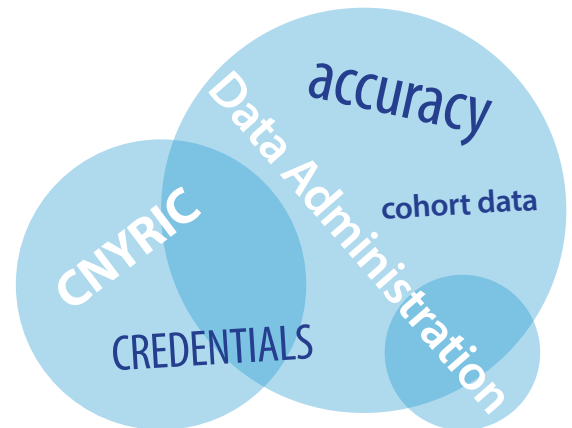
**WHEN:** Friday, April 28, 2017
