Students attend the P-TECH for grades 9-14 earning a Regents Diploma, an industry-recognized Associate Degree from OCC in Electrical Engineering Technology or Mechanical Technology, while gaining relevant work experience in the field of advanced manufacturing. The schools, higher education and industry partners create a seamless program experience for students to acquire the academic, technical, and workplace skills and knowledge that employers in our region need.
