CNYRIC Support:

- ❑ Start of School Year Items:
 - Student Services offers all day teacher support sessions at schools near the end of marking periods.
 - Teacher passwords are not managed by CNYRIC.
 - Shared staff and relocated staff accounts were discussed.
- ❑ CNYRIC Items:
 - CNYRIC and Student Services thanked the group for all that it had contributed to the improvement and enhancement of MyGradebook through the years.
 - CNYRIC is working with FEN to create a large scale archival process for the existing gradebook data after the expiration of MyGradebook. Additional information to follow.

- ❑ CNYRIC Items: (continued)
 - The changing focus of the Group was discussed. Improving the teacher and parent MyGradebook experience is the new focus for the group.
 - The group was shown how to sort the drop-down display of classes.
 - Different Parent Portal preferences were discussed.
 - Features of the Grading Scale were discussed.
 - Non Numeric Scores and how to add and edit them were discussed.

SISWeb Gradebook

- ❑ The final portion of the User Group meeting was a demonstration of the new SISWeb Gradebook in its present form. Test data on the SIS production machine was used for the demonstration.
 - Beginning with a demonstration to the Customer Service Advisory Committee (CSAC), demonstrations of SISWeb Gradebook will be scheduled via webinar, at CNYRIC and in school districts.
 - Limited implementation of the SISWeb Gradebook is planned for spring 2012.
 - Student Services recommends a similar support structure as has been used for the MGB group for the implementation, training and improvement of the SISWeb Gradebook.
- ❑ Some highlights of SISWeb Gradebook:
 - ❖ SISWeb Gradebook is a new module of SIS. It requires no integration.
 - ❖ Teachers using SISWeb will have familiarity with the SISWeb interface.
 - ❖ Single teacher account within a district.
 - ❖ Predefined Exam Assignments such as Final and Regents exams.
 - ❖ Direct integration from Regents Scoring service to SISWeb Gradebook.
 - ❖ SISWeb Gradebook provides flexibility in what is displayed to parents.
 - ❖ Parent access via relationships defined in SISWeb registration.
