All other charter schools must report overall rating categories but are not required to report subcomponent scores. Charter schools that are not required to implement the §3012-c-d evaluation rating categories (i.e., highly effective, effective, developing, ineffective) must map their local evaluation rating categories to the State rating categories for State reporting purposes.

Notes:

- A staff record must be present in Staff Snapshot before it can be loaded into other staff templates.
- BOCES district superintendents, superintendents and charter school leaders may impose a shorter timeframe for ePMF submissions by teachers.
