

CIVIL RIGHTS DATA COLLECTION (CRDC) REPORTING

Every Local Education Agency is responsible for reporting to the Federal Office for Civil Rights this year. CRDC data is collected on various leading civil rights indicators to help ensure equitable educational opportunities.

The Educational Data Services staff have developed resources that will provide you with data for many of the tables in the Federal report. In this workshop, we will provide you with those resources, as well as step-by-step guidance for reporting the data.

The cost is \$240 per district for Cognos CRDC report access. Only one person per district should register for access to the CRDC Cognos reports. There is no cost to attend the CRDC workshop. Individuals should each register separately to attend the workshop.

Participants who attend this workshop will be able to:

- State the purpose of CRDC reporting
- Identify the appropriate resources for CRDC data
- Navigate and download the CRDC Cognos reports
- Access CRDC discipline components in Schooltool, including using the Dashboards
- Apply knowledge to effectively complete the CRDC submission
