
Taught many notable performers including Horatio Hernandez (of Santana), Jim Chapin (father of folk singer-songwriter Harry Chapin).

Performed throughout the Southwestern United States, and Central and Latin America with the acclaimed Long Island Youth Orchestra



### **SEL Framework**

Social and emotional learning (SEL) is the process through which children and adults understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions.


