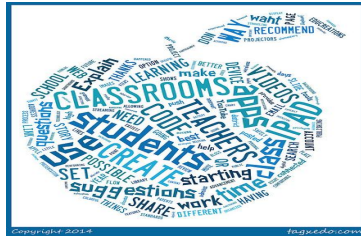
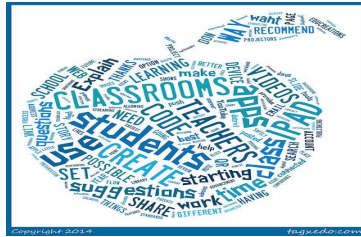


EdCamp Session Topic: Multi-Tiered Systems of Support



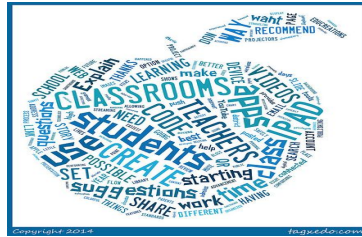
- MTSS- Climate & behaviors
- PBIS takes care of climate
- SEL- Social Emotional Learning
- Principal needs to support along with whole building
- CASEL- Website to go to to find out what programs are evidence based
- National Center for evidence based interventions
- Till soil→ If you don't meet basic needs then academic will be difficult
- Need to find place to get the right training
- Teach expectations then targets to learn
- Mid-November Jim is trying to get a group together (MTSS Training)
- Universal Screening should show what areas students are struggling with the most
- Lost School by Ross Green
- BIMAS-2 Screener looks at a variety of behaviors-want to know who is at risk and changes over time (Progress Monitoring)
- 4 composites, teachers, students, self (12+), outside provider, parent
- Once data is gathered→ look at levels of risk, identifying high risk students
- Frequency of assessment 1,2,3x per year
- Need to determine what interventions are not working
- Spend \$1 in prevention, save \$11 in interventions
- Student threat and action protocol- working on putting together
- 4-5% of students who need mental health services actually get them

Scheduling RtI & WIN



- Concerns: AIS model to more Rtl-based model
- Best way to group kids to meet needs? AIS, Rtl, WIN?
 - Idea: Math 20 min whole group, 40 min groups
- How to group: STAR data and...?
- How often to “switch” groups?
- Shift from AIS to data-driven grouping
- Rtl providers start with Tier III and work our way up
- Classroom teacher will also provide tier II instruction
- Group for 3-4 weeks, progress monitor weekly
- Restructure groups/intervention/targeted skill monthly
- How to fix it if you feel like its not working?
