



The Leadership Principles help the children see:

- Respectful choices, making deposits in other's bank accounts, and considering third alternatives lead to a safe, caring, and pleasant environment
- When they listen with their ears and their heart to understand another person's point of view they show empathy and understanding. When they share, they show courage to voice their ideas or feelings.






