
PBIS is a organizational framework that utilizes an evidence-based instructional approach to behavior through multi-tiered systems of support.

It is not a program or a curriculum.


The Purpose of PBIS




- Increase positive behavior.

Students engage in self-advocacy and are involved in determining their own educational goals and plan.


Parents, and other family members, are engaged as meaningful partners in the special education process and the education of their child.




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
