



### **Head Bands**

## Communication & Roll Over Tips

Districts' URLs will be updated for the AWS platform. Once the district receives the update, check to see that it opens.



Existing sites should redirect to the new URL, if this does not happen it may be blocked. Check district filters if necessary.

Check any links districts have to their Renaissance site to make sure they are still linking correctly.

#### Tips for Logging in the first time:

Students: log in as usual




Passwords will NOW be case sensitive for all staff!

#### **Teachers:**

3 character minimum, including at least 2 of the following: uppercase, lowercase, number, special character (!#\$%-\_=+<>\*)

District personnel, school staff and, school level administrators: 10 character minimum, including at least 3 of the following: uppercase, lowercase, number, special character (!#\$%-\_=+<>\*)
