Consider each graph and the story it tells. The following questions might help prompt your thinking:

- Duration: Has enough data been collected to make informed decisions?
- **Frequency:** Is data being collected often enough to give an accurate picture of student growth?
- "Noisy" Data: Is there too much variance in the data? Why/why not?
- Intervention Lines: Are appropriate interventions identified?
- Goal: Are the goals appropriate and ambitious?
- **Fidelity & Standardization:** Is this the best measure and is administration being done correctly?
- Other Factors? What other information or data might influence your decision-making?
