#### Optoma Digital Projectors & AV Bid List – Jim Leary & Mike Rozniak

Replacement lamps for Optoma projectors are not currently on bid list; discussions with vendors are taking place. Original lamps have one-year warranty; replacements only 90 days and will be ordered as needed but not stocked. Warranty registrations should be submitted. To know when warranty expires, Jim suggested recording the date of purchase on a sticker and placing it on the equipment (writing on unit will void warranty).

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Bid list will run for 7 months (May-November). Mike mentioned that Flat Screen TV's and Carts are new items on bid list. ## MediaCONNECT (SNAP) Update - Rick Pollard/Amy Spath

MediaCONNECT is the CNYRIC "branded" name for SNAP, a web-based media system with integrated booking. This exciting instructional resource will soon be available through the CRC Media Library and offers new media collections and a new emphasis on professional development. Featured digital collections include: NBC News Archives on Demand, Discovery Education Streaming, Learn 360, ITD MediamiX, Soundzabound, and Vital New York. The CRC is working to move as many collections as possible inside the CNYRIC WAN.

MediaCONNECT will allow for student access but can be controlled by district with possibly one generic student login per building to limit content to appropriate grade level. Students will be able to search/find/download, but will not have booking capability. The issue of having multiple users per login is being addressed.

Amy gave a live demonstration of MediaCONNECT. Meeting attendees offered valuable comments about the following topics that will enhance the MediaCONNECT service:

- Log-in procedures
- Length of storage
- Order confirmation
- Notification of discontinued items
- Booking extensions
- Options for saving other than 'C' drive
- Updating user lists
- New account set up
- Tracking data usage at district level
- Downloading procedures
- Image collections
- Methods for "getting the word out" to teachers

NBC News Archives on Demand and Discovery Streaming material is mostly geared toward MS/HS grade levels and is included in the cost of CRC services. Elementary schools who want to consider purchasing should contact Amy. Districts purchasing direct from Discovery are reminded that the service is available from the Curriculum Resource Center.

*Rick reminded Council members that any plans to allow student access must be coordinated with their district's technology director to ensure sufficient bandwidth.*
